## Monthly Costs

AOA Student Board: \$600/month

Non-Student, in lessons and/or training with AOA: \$650/month

Non-Student, NOT in regular lessons or training with AOA: \$800/month

Turnout and Care \$250 per horse – MANDATORY

## Lessons

Riders in the School Horse Lesson Program must purchase lessons in pre-paid, quarterly packages that are priced as follows:

Group lesson (up to 5 people, 1 hour): \$32/lesson

Semi-Private (2 people, ½ hour): \$37/lesson

Students will be allowed a limited number of make-up lessons per details in quarterly lesson registration packages.

Riders that take lessons with our Head Trainer or riders that own or lease a horse will be billed monthly as lessons are taken. All lessons will be billed at the following rate: \$50/lesson.

## Training

Ride \$40

Lunge \$15

## Facility Use

Trailer-in Day use (no stall)

AOA Student or Alum \$10/day

Non-student \$20/day

Short-term boarding \$40/day

## Trailing

1 Horse - \$2/loaded mile\*

2 Horses or more - \$1/load mile/horse\*

Local horse show shipping (within 30 minutes) will be charged at a flat rate of \$50 round trip.

Away shows will be priced according to number of horses and distance traveled.

\*Employee time and expense may be charged additionally when applicable at \$15/hour. A surcharge may apply if fuel costs go above \$3.00/gallon.

## Lease Options

AOA students have priority on leasing, but community students can also lease school horses if they are available. Lease terms will vary, but the following policies will generally apply:

### • **Half Lease**

- 5 days per week -- 3 for hacking/practice rides, 2 for lessons
- Rider must designate days and times of use so that horse can be available for additional lesson use.
- Priority on all horse show use

**Continued on reverse side**

- No additional charges for show use on or off the property
- Fees will be based on ½ of monthly board, \$70/month for farrier, \$40/month for vet and the lease price of the horse (\$200-\$400/month)
- Total estimated cost: \$785-\$985/month\*

• **Full Lease**

- Exclusive right to the horse (other than AOA IEA shows—approximately 3 times per year)
- Exclusive showing privileges of the horse
- No additional charges for ANY use at shows, clinics, etc.
- Lessee will pay the full lease fee of the horse (\$400-\$800/month) and will be billed directly for all expenses of the horse—full board, farrier and vet.
- Total estimated cost: \$1,450-\$1,950\*

\*Prices will vary depending on the horse and on the rider's student status.

**Horse Shows**

Coaching Fees (Rider/owner is showing)

AOA Shows \$50/day

Away Shows \$60/day + expenses

Professional Show Rides \$40/ride

Day Care-Partial \$35

Day Care-Full \$70

**Use of AOA Horse**

AOA Horse Show \$40/day

Away Show or Clinic \$60/day (Charge will be applied every day that horse is off-campus and unavailable for AOA use.)

\*\*Horses will only be used by one rider each day at shows and/or clinics.

**Sales and Purchases**

Trial w/Professional \$100/day + travel expenses (Trainer will go with client to look at and/or try horses to buy.)

Commissions on sale, purchase, or lease: 10% of horse's price

**Grooming (Included in Turnout and Care Fee)**

Show Clip \$25

Mane pull \$25

Laundry \$5/load

**Emergency Services**

Day \$15/hr.

Night/Holiday \$25/hr.

*Note:* Emergency services = 1 hour minimum and pro-rated for actual time after first hour

Injection Fee \$5 + cost of medication

Non-emergency care and services \$15/daytime hour + materials and/or medication

**Additional Services and Fees**

Show entries, braiding, private shipping, veterinarian, blacksmith bills, feed supplements, etc. are to be paid directly by the client (except under terms of AOA lease). If AOA pays these fees on behalf of the client, a 10% handling charge will be billed.
